The HQ / Start & Finish areas are located at the top of the hill next to Heaton Hall. Gazebos and tents can be erected around the Start and Finish area.

Heaton Park has 4 large car parks. Hall Car Park is the closest to Heaton Park Hall, but tends to be the busiest on race day. All the other car parks are walkable to the start & Finish area.

Pay and Display Fees

- Up to one hour £1.50
- One to three hours £2.50
- Over three hours £3.50

How To Pay For Parking

- Cash or card at the machine in the car park - display the ticket in your windscreen
- Pay online using our [PayByPhone](#) mobile phone app using the specific car park ID code. A ticket not required for this option, but you need to download the app and register before you can use it.

Vehicles should only be left in designated car parks. Please park with consideration for other users.

Disabled parking is available in all the car parks; it's free of charge for Blue Badge holders. You can park in any bay, it doesn't have to be a specific disabled bay, but your Blue Badge must be visible.

Public transport

Metrolink offers [Park and Ride](#) car parks right across the tram network which are free to use for Metrolink customers. The Park and Rides at Bury Interchange, Radcliffe and Whitefield offer a quick and easy way to get to Heaton Park and Bowker Vale stops, both of which are within just a few minutes walking distance of the park.
